
Crowley reflects on legendary officiating career

For 35 years, Mickey Crowley ran up and down the basketball court as a referee, officiating in some of the biggest college basketball games in the country.

Now, the 83-year-old sits in his Carolina room at his home in Crow Creek and watches a squirrel run back and forth in the backyard.

Crowley, a native of Queens, N.Y., is a member of six halls of fame and is widely regarded as one of the best college basketball officials of all time. He spent his adult years rubbing elbows with some of the game's finest coaches and players, including Patrick Ewing, John Thompson, Grant Hill, Mike Krzyzewski, Chris Mullin, Lou Carnesecca, P.J. Carlisemo, Rollie Massimino and John Chaney, among others, and that wasn't even his full-time job. For many years, his full-time gig was as a Nassau County administrator who assigned officials for hundreds of high school, college and junior college sporting events. 


